

Clearview Open House / Ribbon Cutting Ceremony June 5, 2011

An Open House showcasing Phase I of the new Clearview Facility is scheduled for Sunday June 5, 2011. The open house is scheduled from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. A ribbon cutting ceremony will be held at 11:30 a.m.

Phase I includes the Towne Centre, which will be the central location for all events. This area will house a salon, library, café, gift shop, and gathering place. A 16-bed household is part of this phase which has been designed as an open concept living arrangement. Phase II of the project will begin in June 2011, with final completion scheduled for the Fall of 2012. Upon completion, Clearview will be home for 236 residents within the 201,000 square foot building.

The state of the art facility incorporates a "Household" design feature. Households are designed for a 16, 20, or 30 bed living area, each having their own kitchen, fireplace, and sitting/TV room. Outside of each dining area, there is a garden area with walkways and sitting areas that are accessible off the dining room of each household. Each resident will have their own private room, with individual bathroom and shower.

Technology includes visual display boards offering those who reside at Clearview easy access to the events going on either locally within the household or community wide. Wireless internet access is available in all rooms.

Therapy services will include outpatient therapy services for the community.

Areas of care for individuals located within its own independent households include:

- Short term rehab
- Clearview Brain Injury and Rehab Center
- Clearview Behavioral Health
- Developmental Disability Household
- Geriatric Care
- Dementia Care
