

Cost Share Funding for Conservation Activities

Cost share funding is available to Dodge County farmers and landowners to install a variety of land & water conservation practices. Funds are provided by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection – Soil & Water Resource Management section. Conservation practices commonly cost shared with these funds include grassed waterways, critical area stabilization, channel crossings, water diversions, barnyard runoff control, rural well abandonment, and manure storage abandonment.
