

Tax Relief from the Farmland Preservation Program

Dodge County landowners with actively farmed cropland may qualify for tax relief under the Wisconsin Working Lands Initiative - Farmland Preservation Program. This program is currently available to landowners in the Towns of Trenton, Leroy, Lomira, Burnett, Williamstown, Theresa, Calamus, Oak Grove, Herman, Elba, Portland, Shields, and Ashippun. Qualifying landowners may be able to receive a per acre tax credit of up to \$5.00 per qualifying acre under long-term agreement, or up to \$7.50 per qualifying acre under Farmland Preservation Zoning. To be eligible for this tax credit, landowners must comply with state soil erosion control and nonpoint pollution control conservation standards.
