Nutrient Management Farmer Training (Write Your Own NM Plan)

Snap-Plus Farmer Training (Computer)

Snap-Plus is computer software designed for Wisconsin farmers to prepare their NM plan.

- You will have a chance to work on your NM plan using Snap-Plus.
- Learn how to use Snap-Plus to make crop nutrient recommendations.
- Snap-Plus is an excellent tool for tracking nutrient applications and updating your NM plan every year.

*You must have current soil tests (within last four years) on a 5 ac/sample basis.

A NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN IS A TOOL FARMERS CAN USE TO JUSTIFY FERTILIZER INPUTS, AND HELP REDUCE THE CHANCE OF NUTRIENT LOSSES TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

IN THE COMING MONTHS UW-EXTENSION AND DODGE COUNTY LCD WILL BE CONDUCTING THREE DIFFERENT NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.

FIND OUT THE VALUE OF MANURE AS A FERTILIZER. TAKE FULL CREDIT FOR ALFALFA AND OTHER LEGUMES. LEARN HOW MUCH FERTILIZER TO APPLY BASED ON UW RECOMMENDATIONS.

IF YOU WOULD LIKE YOUR MANURE SPREADER WEIGHED, CALL LAND CONSERVATION @ (920) 386-3660. IF YOU KNOW HOW MUCH MANURE IS GOING ON AN ACRE, YOU KNOW HOW MUCH NUTRIENT VALUE TO CREDIT.

SOIL TESTING CAN HELP INDICATE WHERE FERTILIZER OR LIME WILL IMPROVE CROP YIELDS. IF YOU NEED SOIL TESTS, HAVE THEM TAKEN ON A 5 AC/SAMPLE BASIS. SOIL TESTS SHOULD BE TAKEN EVERY 4 YEARS. FALL SOIL SAMPLING IS BEST.

These programs are offered to producers on a voluntary basis. When are Nutrient Plans required?

- Anyone in the Farmland Preservation Program
- Anyone installing or altering manure storage structures.
- Expanding operations going thru livestock siting ordinance.
- Operations under DNR WPDES permits (CAFO's/more than 1000 animal units)

(Q) How often do I have to update my Nutrient plan? (A) Annually. (Winter) Prior to the growing season.

(Q) Do grain producers (no manure) need a nutrient plan? (A) Yes.

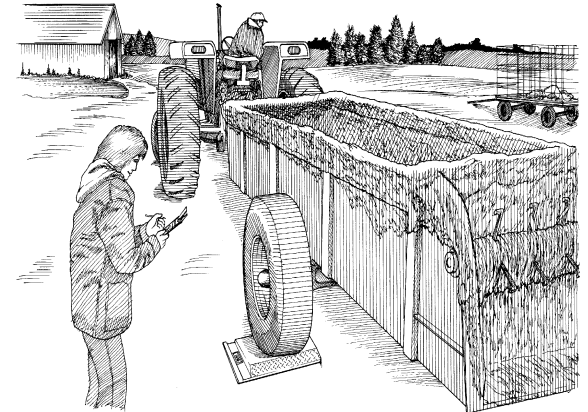
