INITIAL RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING GENERAL
OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$22,385,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Watertown Unified School District, Jefferson and Dodge Counties, Wisconsin that there shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$22,385,000 for the public purpose of paying or reimbursing the cost of improving the infrastructure of all school district buildings; constructing additions to the Douglas, Webster and Schurz Elementary Schools; and acquiring equipment, furnishings and fixtures.
