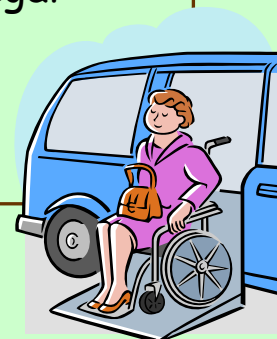
Transportation Program



Welcome to the Dodge County Human Services & Health Department's Transportation Program - Volunteer & Staff Drivers providing safe, enjoyable rides for Dodge County residents. The Transportation Program, staff, and volunteers have a responsibility to provide safe rides, make sure the person is on time for their appointment, plus be respectful and courteous to the rider receiving the service. Wheelchair accessible vans and volunteer drivers using their own vehicles are scheduled to transport riders. Once scheduled, the transportation office will confirm the ride by mailing a postcard to the rider. If the rider does not receive a postcard, they should please call the transportation office to make sure there is a ride and driver scheduled.

To be Eligible to receive services, the rider must be a resident of Dodge County. Rides will be scheduled based on the following trip priority:

Please provide the following information with
each ride request:

- √ **3 Or More Business** Days Advance Notice
- √ Your Name, Address, Phone Number
- √ Your Date of Birth
- √ Destination address and phone number
- √ Length of appointment
- √ Is a return trip needed
- √ Who will be paying for the ride

IMPORTANT NOTE: The Transportation Program is CANCELLED when weather conditions make traveling hazardous. Local radio and television stations announce such closings. Radio stations that announce weather closings are 1430 AM WBEV, 95.3 FM WXRO, 1170 AM WMRH, 1580 AM WTTN, 1540 AM WTKM and 105 FM WTKM. Television stations that announce closings are 4, 6 and 12. Please watch and listen to local TV and radio stations during inclement weather to see if transportation is closed. If you are not sure if rides for Dodge County Transportation are cancelled, please call Transportation.
