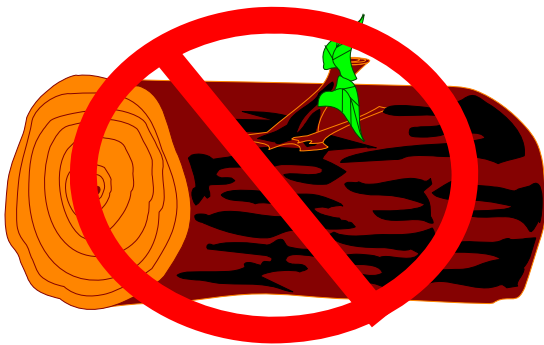


FIREWOOD BAN

IN EFFECT AT THIS PARK

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2008



**FIREWOOD MAY NO
LONGER BE BROUGHT
INTO THE PARK!**

****This ban also includes pallets, lumber scraps and any other wood.****

If you have firewood with you:

1. Take it back home, or
2. Place it in a sealed container or bag and keep it in your vehicle for the duration of your stay.

Failure to comply with this policy could result in revocation of camping permit and/or issuance of a citation.

Why the Firewood Ban?

Dodge County is taking a pro-active approach to the impending invasion of the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) to Wisconsin and Dodge County. EAB has already killed 20 million ash trees in south-east Michigan, Ohio, Indiana and Ontario, Canada. Firewood is a major source of new infestations, not only from EAB, but other invasive pests as well, which place the tree resources of the parks and Dodge County communities at risk. Park staff will work diligently to assure an ample supply of firewood is available for purchase (\$3 per bundle) in the parks during the season. We apologize for the inconvenience this new rule may cause for you, but it is necessary in order to provide protection of the Dodge County Parks' tree resources so valued by you and other park visitors. Thanks for your cooperation in helping to stop the spread of EAB and protecting our parks.
