
Wild Goose State Trail

Located adjacent to the airport, the Wild Goose State Trail is a 34-mile multi-use recreational trail. Bicycling, walking and horseback riding is permitted year round and snowmobile and ATV use is allowed during the winter months, weather permitting.

Located only three miles from the airport and adjacent to the Wild Goose State Trail, is Nitschke Mounds County Park. The Park contains about 40 preserved animal effigy, conical and linear mounds believed to have been constructed around 800 AD-1100 AD. The mounds represent one of the best surviving examples of the mound builders culture.

Further to the north along the trail, access to paved hiking/biking paths within the Horicon Marsh National Wildlife Refuge can be found.

- ✦ The Dodge County Airport recently expanded by investing \$1.2 million in a new hangar and terminal facility. This allows Wisconsin Aviation to hangar numerous planes year round.
- ✦ With a length of 5,060 feet, runway 8/26 can accommodate large business jets, giving the traveler the opportunity to reach many large businesses in the area.

Dodge County

Dodge County was created in 1836 and named in honor of Henry Dodge, then territorial governor of Wisconsin. In 1845 iron ore was discovered in Mayville and an iron ore works operated here for several decades until competition from mines in the Lake Superior region closed them. Currently Dodge County has nearly 90,000 residents.

Dodge County is home to the 32,000 acre Horicon Marsh, the largest freshwater cattail marsh in the United States. Dodge County also has over 21,000 acres of surface water, including 31 lakes and 50 rivers and streams.

Quad/Graphics with 12,000 employee's world wide and 2 billion in annual sales operates two facilities in Dodge County and employs nearly 2,700 persons in the County. Quad/Graphics is the world's largest privately held printer of magazines, catalogs, and other commercial products.

Employing over 900 people in Dodge County is John Deere Horicon Works. John Deere employs 47,000 people worldwide and is the world's leading manufacturer of farm equipment.

In 2005, Progressive Farmer Magazine picked Dodge County as the 12th Best Place to live in Rural America. Counties were ranked by health care, education, climate, pollution, crime, and tax burden.

Revolving Loan Program

Because Dodge County knows that business is the lifeblood of its economy, Dodge County Land Resources and Parks operates a revolving loan program for local businesses and industry. Sometimes, businesses can find themselves in unique situations where conventional bank financing is not an option.

The Revolving Loan Fund program provides low-interest loans for proposed projects that will create new jobs, help businesses maintain or expand existing operations, and advance the county's economic development goals and objectives. The Fund is intended to provide a financial incentive for business and industries to invest in their own growth by providing "leverage". The funds, therefore, are meant to serve an important, secondary role to the private financing available.

Available Land and Buildings Inventory

The Dodge County Land Resources and Parks Department maintains a current inventory of available industrial buildings and vacant land available for industrial development.

The County offers 11 industrial parks distributed within 9 of the County's communities. The inventory permits a rapid response to inquiries from companies wishing to expand or relocate to Dodge County.
