

DODGE COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE

The Dodge County Drug Task Force is comprised of 12 local law enforcement agencies that join resources to combat drug trafficking in Dodge County. The Drug Task Force is also a partner in SEADOG, the South-East Area Drug Operations Group. This group is a partnership of Dodge, Walworth, Jefferson, Racine, and Kenosha Counties. These agencies coordinate the exchange of intelligence information, manpower, and equipment to maximize drug enforcement efforts.

The Drug Task Force made 152 arrests, including 30 prescription drug related arrests in 2008. The Task Force shut down 2 methamphetamine laboratories, one located inside a motel. Crack cocaine arrests increased almost 200% since 2006. Heroin use is on the rise and has resulted in numerous arrest in 2009 and one overdose death.
